Creative ways to re-use your holiday cards

It won't be long before your mailbox starts to get flooded with holiday cards! There are many creative ways that you can re-use these cards, so don't toss them away quite yet...

One of the most simple ways that I re-use my own cards is to make them into gift tags. Simply cut around an image on the front of the card, with regular or pattern-edged scissors. Use a hole punch to



make a hole in one corner to attach to gifts with ribbon, and use the white back to write who the gift is for and from!

Another fun way to re-use your old gift cards is to turn them into unique ornaments. These ornaments can be made in a variety of sizes to hang on your tree, or anywhere else around your house. They can even make a nice gift! This project is more involved than gift tags, so I
